Steve Goldfein is sector vice president of Strategy Development & Deployment (SD&D) for Northrop Grumman's Mission Systems sector, a leading global provider, manufacturer and integrator of advanced, secure and agile software-defined systems and solutions.

As the leader for SD&D, Goldfein has responsibility for the sector's strategy with an emphasis on investment alignment. He is focused on advancing Mission Systems in the areas of digital transformation, open architecture and multi-functional mission-level solutions. Goldfein also ensures close alignment with the Corporate Chief Strategy Office and Government Relations function to achieve sector objectives.

Most recently, Goldfein held the position of sector vice president of Business Development (BD), where he led the strategic planning and development of new business opportunities throughout the Mission Systems sector. Included in this responsibility was executive sponsorship and direction of the sector's business acquisition process, as well as corporate and sector priority wins. Additionally, he had responsibility for alignment to the corporate chief global business development officer, country executives, the sector's pipeline management, and the Capture Center.

Previously, Goldfein held the position of sector vice president of BD for the former Electronic Systems sector. Prior to that, he was sector vice president and deputy of BD for the Aerospace Systems sector. In this role, he provided oversight, integration and direction of BD across the Aerospace Systems sector portfolio. He also played a vital role in management of all BD activities, ensuring close coordination with program managers, business areas and functional organizations.

Goldfein also served as executive lead of the BD team for the Advanced Programs and Technology division where he played a key role in the strategic execution of a number of key programs. He also led the business development strategic analysis team.

In 2008 Goldfein joined Northrop Grumman following a 30-year career in the U.S. Air Force, retiring with the rank of major general. He brings extensive experience in worldwide joint force tactics, operations, testing of combat weapons systems and Pentagon operations and processes. He held a number of key positions in the Air Force, including vice director of the Joint Staff, reporting to the chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff; vice commander, Air Combat Command; commander, U.S. Air Force Warfare Center; and U.S. Air Force Director of Requirements.

Goldfein earned a master's degree in human resources management from Golden Gate University and a master's degree in national security strategy from the National War College. He earned a bachelor's degree in history from the U.S. Air Force Academy. He also received an MIT fellowship in national security strategy. Mr. Goldfein is a command pilot with nearly 4,000 hours of flight time in a wide array of military aircraft, including the F-15A/B/C/D/E, F-16, T-38, B-1, B-2, AWACS, C-130, C-12, F/A-18 and Typhoon.
