Wilson held numerous senior leadership positions at ATK, prior to the Orbital merger, including vice president and general manager of the space systems division at ATK Aerospace Group and vice president of strategy, business development and advanced systems for the Space Systems Group.

Wilson has held key management positions throughout his career at Northrop Grumman, Orbital ATK, ATK and Swales Aerospace and has more than 15 years of government experience with the Department of Defense.

Wilson earned a bachelor's degree in aerospace engineering from the University of Maryland and an executive certificate from Wharton School of the University of Pennsylvania.
